The Promise of Advent

Mary's reply to Angel Gabriel at the Annunciation is celebrated by the Motet and Mass *Dixit Maria* by Hans Leo Hassler, a respected and influential contemporary of William Byrd. Martin Luther's Advent hymn *Nun Komm der Heiden Heiland* (Come Saviour of the Nations) inspired many composers. The Choir's sequence features uplifting settings by 14 of them, from a Bohemian bishop born in 1483 to Telemann and J S Bach in the 1700s. With soloists from the Choir and strings led by Nicola Bright.
